



Description of Therapies Offered:

Speech Therapy

Alternative and Augmentative Communication - This therapy will focus on the use of devices or the PECS picture exchange communication system to make requests, gain attention, and increase independence in a group setting.

Social Language - This therapy will focus on the individual pragmatic language needs of pre-school/school aged children. The following topics are examples of what will be targeted: turn taking skills, appropriate eye contact, topic maintenance, and social commenting.

Articulation - This therapy will focus on making correct distinct sounds within certain words that are either distorted or omitted. Helping children learn to produce speech sounds clearly enough to be understood by others.

Occupational Therapy

Handwriting - The goal of handwriting therapy is to promote great writing habits in a fun environment before the school year starts. Children will participate in games, crafts, and multi-sensory writing activities. The sessions will be directed by a certified handwriting specialist and experienced occupational therapist. Ideas for home activities will be provided. Each session is for children 4 years of age and up.

Physical Therapy-

Mobility - This therapy is designed for children, under the direction of a physical therapist, to work on improving their classroom mobility, strength, general coordination, safety on playground equipment, and maintaining the endurance for mobility that they had for the school year during the summer. This will be done through therapeutic exercise, practice on specific equipment, and a home program with the family.
